During June, NAP (North American Pairs) qualifying F2F games are scattered throughout the month. If you qualify in a club game, you may participate in the District 14 finals at a later date. (Online qualifying games are June 6-8, \$7) These games pay 50% red, 50% black. If you have questions, please give me a call. We have had quite a few Rochester pairs represent District 14 at the nationals! Also, July 1, 2, & 3 will be Royal Sectional Tournaments at Club (STaC). These games, if you place in the overall in the pooled district, will pay 25% black, 25% silver, 25% red, and 25% gold. Our game file is sent to the director in charge which pools our results with other competing clubs. Points will first show up as silver; at the end of the week, after all results are in, the points will be converted to the above equation. Here's your chance to win some colored points without traveling to a tournament.
